## How to measure your dog for its coat





The arrow shows a measure from the back of the dog's shoulder blades to the bottom of the back a bit before the base of the tail. Do not measure from the collar as this won't come out correct size.

This can be tricky to measure on a wriggly dog, so here are some breed examples to help:

Small (29cm) = Pug, Boston Terrier, Bichon, JRT

Medium (36cm) = Cocker Spaniel, Small Staffy Female, Whippet

Large (40cm) = Springer Spaniel, Border Collie

XLarge (48cm) = Labrador, Dalmatian, GSP

**XXLarge** (62cm) = Very large GSD male, Newfie, Great Dane. This is our largest size and there is a bigger size jump between the XL and the XXL
